"Choreology is a concise and visual script to precisely convey the abundance of information required for analyzing, studying, teaching or reproducing human movement and dance.

Just like a full orchestral score, the notation describes detailed movements and steps in rhythm and phrasing for individuals or groups. "A choreologist produces written scores which are the backbone of full scale ballets, choreographic productions containing all the steps for all the cast,

information on scenery, lighting, costume, and production details."
